Book Club Questions

What effect does Pipp play in Anna's acceptance of Liz's death?

Pip says to Anna, "Dead is dead", which is a harsh reality and seemingly unsympathetic. Is Pipp insensitive? What is the importance of Pipp's honesty in how Anna speaks of Liz's death?

Anna's father shows he is caring in very subtle ways, but for the most part, he is very non-emotional. How has he changed since the setting of this story? How could a more loving father figure have changed Anna's life?

How is Ben significant to the story? Did you feel satisfied that his life and whereabouts remain a mystery?

What was the critical role between Anna and her sister Bridgett?

Was Murph in the right or wrong for what he did to Anna? Was he genuinely sorry for what happened? Why do you think Murph chose to do what he did? And today, what might he think of Anna?
